Day 1

Arrival in Ghana Akwaaba to Ghana! Your adventure starts today as you step foot in Accra. There will be a private shuttle service available to take you to your luxurious accommodation in no time. Once settled, you will get to know the tour team and have the rest of the day to unpack & relax. In the evening, we will enjoy a delicious dinner at a local restaurant as we go over the tour brief. Your Ghana escapade is about to start!

Day 2

Accra Historic City Tour Our adventure starts from Accra, Ghana's bustling capital. We will start the day by touring the city with new smells, tastes & colours. Our tour will take us to W.B Duboi Centre, the Black Star Square & Independence Arch, Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Museum & the National Museum. We will end the day by eating at a local restaurant full of mouthwatering foods!

Day 3

A Tour of Slave Dungeons & Canopy Walkway Bursting with history & pride, Cape Coast is one of Ghana's most significant travel destinations. Discover the city as we revisit some of the country's most painful past. We will dig deep into slavery by stepping on the path of thousands of the enslaved captives. Our journey begins at Assin Manso slave river (Donkor Nsuo) where captured slaves had the chance to bathe before a 3 week naked trek through the dense forest. We will then come back to Kakum National Park to unwind and enjoy Ghana's lush landscapes. The Park has ancient trees, curious monkeys and beautiful birds. There's a canopy trail, a series of 7 narrow swinging canopy bridges. Get face-to-face with exotic fauna as we go through their natural habitat, more than 40 feet above the ground. We will then head back to the Elmina / Cape Cape slave castles for the history of the infamous slave trade.

Day 4:

An exciting visit to the beautiful Aburi Botanical Gardens & Asenema Waterfall We head to the country's most beautiful plants, luscious flowers & unique ecosystems. Aburi Botanical Gardens are found just outside Accra. Bustling with life, it's a great place to take pictures, relax and grab a bite at one of the many nearby restaurants. We then head to Asenema Waterfall, one of the hidden gems in the rainforest of the Akuapem Hills, outside of Accra, and north of Aburi. Asenema waterfall feeds a lively little stream nearby. The falls usually has a very good flow in the rainy season. The drive to get to the falls is wonderfully scenic, with beautiful views across the rolling hills that are so typical of the region.

Day 5:

Day 6:

An exciting visit to Shai Hills Resource Centre & the Bridgeview Beach Resort Boat Cruise The reserve consists of a very striking and attractive range of rocky hills set in the middle of an expansive open and wooded grassland plain. The rocks are visible in many places as impressive and steep cliffs and large and attractive rocky outcrops. The reserve is fenced to prevent animals from straying out. There are beautiful scenic views across the Accra Plain from the top with all kinds of flora and fauna. From here we proceed to The Bridgeview Beach Resort situated in one of the most beautiful locations in Ghana on the banks of the famous Volta River in the Eastern Region of Ghana and about 90 minutes drive from the capital city Accra. The spectacular views and the unique architectural design blends with typical

traditional Ghanaian styles & modernity of the highest international standards makes it an ideal place to enjoy nature. We will enjoy a scheduled cruise on the beautiful Volta lake with live music & enjoy delicious meals at the hotel. We then walk to the iconic Adomi bridge for a photoshoot. This beautiful bridge is a trussed arch spanning the Volta River at the Akosombo Dam at Atimpoku.
