NAMIBIA/BOTS/Zim Road trip at your own pace

The land of Namibia and Botswana awaits you. We take care of booking the hotels and rental cars so that you can enjoy your trip in a relaxed manner.

Itinerary Day 1 - At the beginning of our day, our tour guide will greet our guests and introduce them to the guest waiting at the international airport in Windhoek, the capital of Namibia. Before we drive to the hotels, our tour guide will take an introductory tour of the city. We will stay in Safari's hotels in the city. (BB) (Khomas region).

Day 2 Today after breakfast we drive to Otjiwarongo in the north of Namibia. We will stay at C Esti Hotel. (DBB)

Day 3 - Today we drive to Toshari Lodge after breakfast. The Toshari Lodges are located near Andersson Gate, the southern entrance to Etosha National Park. On our way we make a short stop at the cheetah sanctuary. Here we will see how cheetahs are rescued and released back into the wild. This is the project created to protect cheetahs from poachers. Afternoon game drive in Etosha National Park included.

Day 4-Today full game drive in Etosha National Park. 4x4 open car. Here you have the opportunity to see wild animals like elephants' lions and many more. Etosha National Park is a national park in northwestern Namibia and one of the largest national parks in Africa. It was declared a game reserve in March 1907 in Order 88 by the Governor of German South West Africa, Friedrich von Lindequist. (DBB) Toshari Lodge.

Day -5 Today we drive through the national park to Emany Lodge Etosha (full day game drive). (BB) Emany Lodge.

Day 6 - Today we travel to the Caprivi Strip to a town called Rundu. The Caprivi Strip, also simply called Caprivi, is a geographical protrusion that protrudes from the northeastern corner of Namibia. It borders Botswana to the south and Angola and Zambia to the north. (Afternoon boat trip included) Hakusembe River Lodge (DBB).

Day 7 Today after breakfast we drive to Mahangu River Lodge (boat trip with sunset dinner included) (DBB) (Mahangu-river lodge).

Day 8 Today we drive to Katima Mullilo to the Zambezi lodge We will stay in a hotel that offers a great view over the Zambezi River Enjoy a beautiful sunset from the comfort of your room. (BB) (Zambezi River Lodge)

Day 9 Today we cross the border into Botswana. After a good breakfast and check-out, we travel to Botswana to the town of Kasane. This is a small town located in the famous Chobe National Park. On our way we drive through Chobe Park. Our accommodation will be at Water Lilly Lodge or Chobe Safari Lodge. The lodge is located on the banks of the river. (BB)

Day 10-Today we will start early. Before breakfast we take a nature drive to Chobe National Park. Here you may have a chance to see the Big Five, including leopards, elephants, lions, rhinos and water buffalo. After our breakfast we drive to Zimbabwe. Our journey to Zimbabwe takes about 3 hours. After checking in, the guest has the afternoon at leisure. (DBB) A Zambezi Hotel or Rain Hotel.

Day -11 Today after breakfast we undertake a full day visit to Victoria Falls. Customers can also book a helicopter ride over Victoria Falls or white-water rafting. After the day's activities, customers have the afternoon free. (BB A Zambezi Hotel or Rainbow Hotel.

Day 12 After breakfast, guests are ready to be transferred to the international airport in Zimbabwe. At the airport our tour guide says goodbye again before driving back to Namibia (BB).



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
